Notus School District met one performance target during SY22/23: 3rd grade percentage proficient on the IRI. The other results fell short of previously articulated performance targets, however, seven areas saw higher results this school year over last. In the creation of new targets for this year, analysis was completed regarding what goal targets should be relative to the stated goal to be within 10% age points of the state averages. However, it should be noted, that where that number fell short of 50%, the target was set at 50%. This does mean that several targets for SY23/24 are lower than they had been set last school year in an effort to adjust to a more achievable target relative to the results from the previous year. Data based discussions and professional development will be ongoing throughout the school year in relative grade levels. Notus Elementary is providing specialized training in reading interventions for all teachers and paraprofessionals as well as working with the Regional Math Center. Notus Jr/Sr High is participating in the Accelerated Math Learning Collaborative with Boise State. Additionally, the Board of Trustees maintains a Continuous Improvement Committee that will meet regularly to discuss data checkpoints relative to the performance targets in order to provide ongoing feedback and support to staff as they work to meet performance targets.
